How they are grown

Eels are grown in open waters such as lakes and reservoirs of Sri Lanka. Organic and free range, they feed on the natural abundant food. Adults breed in the ocean and the juveniles, after 2-3 years, re-enter the freshwater through rivers and return to the lakes and reservoirs to grow into adults.

Available as

Live, fresh chilled, fillet.

Available sizes

For live from 150 grams to 2 kilograms.

For fresh/chilled or fillets 500 grams to >2 kilograms

Sustainability details

Divron is the first to develop the culture of eels in Sri Lanka following our principles of natural and sustainable production. Divron does not trade or export glass eels (juveniles), which is a major threat to the natural population. Divron works with rural fisher communities in Sri Lanka to grow the eels, supporting hundreds of families through improved income and better futures.
