Macrobrachium rosenbergii

Family: Palaemonidae



How they are grown

Prawns grow in the clean open waters of the lakes and reservoirs of Sri Lanka. Organic and free range, they feed on the natural abundant food there. Divron breeds the prawns to produce young post-larvae that are stocked in the lakes and reservoirs. They are selectively harvested by local fishers.

Over 400 grams, 250-400 grams, 150-250 grams

Sustainability details

Divron is the first to develop the culture of fresh water prawn in Sri Lanka following our principles of natural and sustainable production. The prawns are native to Sri Lanka. Divron works with rural fisher communities in Sri Lanka to grow the prawns, supporting thousands of families through improved income and better futures.
