How they are grown and harvested

Mud crabs live in the near shore marine areas and coastal lagoons of Sri Lanka. Divron is working with local coastal communities to ensure sustainability of the population, encouraging gear such as traps and gill nets rather than bottom trawls. Divron is also creating a stock enhancement program and encouraging sustainable culture of mud crabs. They are harvested and transported to our live holding facility.
